



Maxbal Genealogy

This chart has space to display the individual's name plus 2 additional lines of information which you type into the appropriate box. An example is shown in the box below. Just replace the information with your own.

To enter information place the cursor on the box that you want to edit and click the left mouse button.

Use "Tab" to move to the next field in a box and to move to the next box

Although it is usual to show a selection of the standard items detailed below you can enter any information that you wish

Standard items are:-

- B. 12 Mar 1854 = birth date
- Ch. 15 Jun 1890 = christening date
- Bap. 29 Sep 1840 = baptised date
- M. 25 Aug 1888 = marriage date
- D. 15 Nov 1903 = death date
- Bu. 9 Sep 1910 = burial date
- O. Blacksmith = Occupation

The conventional way to enter Paternal ancestors is to the left and Maternal ancestors to the right with the male of a partnership appearing in the box above the female.

You should thoroughly check that all information is correct as it will be used to complete your family tree chart.
